1) NEET UG 2025 Overview:

The National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET UG) 2025 is a crucial examination for students aspiring to pursue undergraduate medical courses such as MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BSMS, and BSc Nursing in India. Conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), the exam serves as the gateway to various medical institutions across the country.

2) NEET UG 2025 Application:

The application window for NEET UG 2025 has officially closed. The registration process commenced on **February 7, 2025**, and concluded on March 7, 2025, at 11:50 PM IST.

Registered candidates had the opportunity to make corrections to their application forms from **March 9 to March 11, 2025**. This one-time facility allowed modifications in specific fields such as:

- Parent's name
- Educational qualifications
- State of eligibility
- Category and sub-category
- Disability status
- Signature
- Number of NEET attempts

3) NEET UG Eligibility:

- Age Limit: Minimum age of **17 years as of December 31, 2025**. There is no upper age limit.
- Educational Qualification: Candidates must have passed or appeared in Class 12 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology, and English as core subjects.
- Minimum Marks:
 - General category: 50% aggregate in PCB
 - SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwD: 40% aggregate in PCB

- Total Questions: 200 (180 mandatory)

5) NEET UG 2025 Admit Card:

The NEET (UG) 2025 admit card has been released by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on **May 1, 2025**, ahead of the examination scheduled for **May 4, 2025**.

6) NEET UG Preparation Tips:

1. Understand the Syllabus Thoroughly

- Focus on NCERT Class 11 & 12 for Physics, Chemistry, and Biology—they form the core of NEET questions.
- Cover all topics mentioned in the official NTA syllabus.
- Prioritize high-weightage chapters (e.g., Human Physiology, Genetics, Thermodynamics, Organic Chemistry).

2. Create a Realistic Study Schedule

- Allocate 6–8 hours per day (if starting from scratch).
- Follow the Pomodoro Technique (25 min study + 5 min break).
- Dedicate time weekly for revision and mock tests.

3. Practice Regularly

- Solve daily MCQs for each subject.

4. Master NCERT First

- 80–85% of NEET Biology and a large portion of Chemistry questions are directly from NCERT.
- Highlight facts, diagrams, and footnotes.
- Revise Biology NCERTs at least 5–6 times.

5. Take Full-Length Mock Tests

- Simulate real exam conditions every 10–15 days.
- Analyze your performance: identify weak topics and silly mistakes.
- Focus on time management and question selection skills.

6. Develop Conceptual Clarity

- For Physics, focus on concepts + formula application.
- In Chemistry, divide time between Organic, Inorganic, and Physical.
- In Biology, develop diagram-base and factual recall abilities.

- Eat balanced meals and sleep 7–8 hours daily.
- Practice meditation or light exercise to reduce anxiety.
- Avoid burnout—take breaks, talk to peers, and stay positive.

7) NEET UG 2025 Analysis:

The **NEET UG 2025** exam, held on **May 4**, has been widely regarded as one of the toughest editions in recent years². Over **22 lakh students** appeared for the exam, and many have taken to social media to express their concerns about the difficulty level

Subject-wise Analysis:

Physics: Considered the most challenging section, with lengthy and complex questions. Some were even at JEE Advanced level, making time management difficult.

Chemistry: Rated moderate to difficult, with a strong focus on Organic and Physical Chemistry. Many questions required conceptual understanding rather than direct recall.

Biology: Though based on the NCERT syllabus, the section was lengthy and included conceptual and application-based question.

Student Reactions:

Many students found the Biology paper lengthy, while Physics was particularly tough. Some even questioned whether the paper setters themselves could solve it within the given time. Experts predict that cut-off scores may be lower this year due to the increased difficulty.

Paper Analysis:

The NEET analysis is prepared based on the student reactions and reviews by experts. While the student reactions may vary from one to another as each student has a different perspective, the expert review is a more credible source of NEET analysis.

The difficulty level of NEET may vary for candidates, based on their preparation level. Based on the expertise and experience, the NEET analysis by experts will provide a more in-depth overview of the exam for each subject, topics, syllabus coverage and weightage. Expert analysis for NEET will also act as a basis of preparation for aspirants planning to appear for the exam next year.

However, student reactions give a first-hand impression of the exam which cannot be ruled out. It gives a glance to the NEET question paper and the personal feedback of candidates. NEET analysis by student reactions help evaluate the overall performance of candidates and the expected cutoff.

9) NEET UG 2025 Cutoff:

The NEET UG 2025 exam was conducted on **May 4, 2025**, and the results are expected to be declared by **June 14, 2025**. The National Testing Agency (NTA) will release the official cutoff scores following the result declaration. Factors Influencing NEET UG 2025 Cutoff

The actual cutoff scores will depend on various factors, including:

- **Difficulty Level of the Examination:** A more challenging exam may result in lower cutoff scores.
- **Number of Applicants:** An increase in the number of candidates can lead to higher competition and potentially higher cutoff scores.
- **Number of Seats Available:** More available seats may lead to lower cutoff scores, while fewer seats can increase the cutoff.
- **Reservation Policies:** State-specific reservation policies can influence the cutoff scores.

10) NEET UG 2025 Counseling:

The NEET UG 2025 counselling process is expected to commence in **July 2025**, following the declaration of results in **June 2025**. The Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) will conduct the All India Quota (AIQ) counselling, while individual states, including Telangana, will manage their respective state quota counselling.

The NEET counselling process will be conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) in online mode, except for the last round, which is the institute reporting process, wherein candidates have to be physically present at the allotted institute for document verification and complete the admission process. There will be approximately five to six rounds of NEET 2025 counselling, and the rounds may be extended based on the number of vacant seats.

The NEET 2025 counselling can be divided into two types, for the 15 per cent All India Quota (AIQ) seats and 85 per cent State Quota (SQ) seats. While MCC conducts the counselling process for the AIQ seats, State Counselling authorities conduct the NEET State Counselling process.

1. Registration Process

- Official Website: Visit mcc.nic.in for AIQ counselling.
- Registration Steps:
- Click on the 'New Registration 2025' tab.
- Enter mandatory details such as NEET UG roll number, parent's name, date of birth, and security code.
- Create a password and complete the registration form by entering personal, educational, and NEET 2025 details.
- Upload scanned photograph and signature.
- Pay the registration fee and take a printout of the registration confirmation page.

2. Counselling Fees

- AIQ/Central Universities
- General: ₹1,000 (non-refundable)
- SC/ST/OBC/PwD: ₹500 (non-refundable)

11) NEET UG 2025 Answer Key:

The NEET UG 2025 examination was conducted on **May 4, 2025**. As per the National Testing Agency (NTA), the provisional answer key is expected to be released in the fourth week of **May 2025**, approximately a month after the exam. Candidates will have a window of 4–5 days to challenge the provisional answer key before the final answer key is published in the second week of **June 2025**. The NEET UG 2025 results are anticipated to be declared in mid-June 2025.

NEET UG is a national-level entrance exam conducted for admission to MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, and other undergraduate medical courses in India.

2. Who conducts NEET UG 2025?

NEET UG 2025 is expected to be conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA).

- SC/ST/OBC: Minimum 40% marks in PCB
